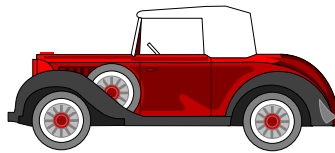

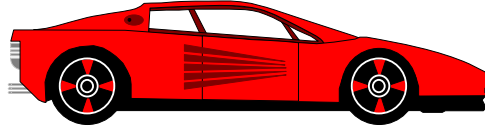
No Food or Drink is permitted in the gym

PINEWOOD DERBY RULES

Only one “race” car is allowed per person. However, you may also enter a “Design Only” car. For those parents that wish to show their skills in car design, we encourage you to enter into either the Open class or Design Only class.

Construction Rules

**Because of limitations with our new Finish Gate, we must limit the cars height to 3”
In the past, we had the Open Class height limit set to 5”**

Kindergarten through 3rd grade:

Length:	maximum - 7 3/8”	minimum - none
Width:	maximum - 2 3/4”	minimum - 1 7/8” between wheels
Height:	maximum - 3”	minimum - none
Weight:	maximum - 6 oz.	minimum - none

(See notes below regarding attachments and wheels)

Open Class:

Length:	maximum - 10”	minimum - none
Width:	maximum - 3 1/4”	minimum - 1 7/8” between wheels
Height:	maximum - 3”	minimum - none
Weight:	maximum - 6 oz.	minimum - none

(See note below regarding attachments and wheels)

Design Only: **THESE CARS DO NOT RACE**

No minimums or maximums for Length, Width, Height or Weight

Note on Attachments:

As long as the attachments adhere to the rules governing the Length, Width, Height and Weight, and are securely attached, they are allowed.

Note on Wheels: (probably the most contested issue)

Wheels and axles **MUST** be those furnished with the official YMCA kits without exception. Wheels may be smoothed to eliminate mold marks, but they **MAY NOT** be thinned, tapered or shaped in any manner. Lubricants are permitted - graphite is recommended. Cars must be freewheeling with no starting devices. No wheel bearings, bushings, sleeves, etc. are permitted. The car shall not ride on any type of spring(s).
